SEQUIM, WA — A male pedestrian was critically injured late Tuesday night in a hit-and-run collision on US Highway 101 near Washington Road following reports of an altercation, according to the PenCom dispatch center.

At approximately 11:05 p.m. on 10/8/2024, PenCom dispatch received a 911 call reporting two men fighting on the roadway in the westbound lanes of Highway 101. Shortly afterward, a second 911 call was received, reporting that one of the men had been struck by a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed.

Clallam County Fire District 3 (CCFD3) firefighters and paramedics responded swiftly to the scene. Upon arrival, they stabilized the critically injured male, believed to be between 45 and 50 years old, and coordinated with Life Flight to airlift him to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle. The patient was transported to the Sequim Helipad and flown to Harborview, where his condition remains undisclosed. Responding units included Engines 37 and 34, Rescue 34, Aide 37 and 34, and a Battalion Chief, totaling ten personnel.

Safety and Awareness: This incident underscores the importance of being cautious on highways and reporting suspicious or dangerous activity.
