# APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Miano moved and Commissioner Nicholas seconded to approve the February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Regular Meeting minutes. **MOTION CARRIED**.

## **REGULAR BUSINESS**

**Agenda Bill 1: Facilitated Board Workshop** – Commissioner Chinn was tasked with securing proposals from consulting firms to facilitate a Board Workshop. The focus of the Workshop is determining the direction the Commissioners want the district to go based on the changes in leadership roles with the addition of Battalion Chiefs. ESCi submitted the only proposal received. Commissioner Miano moved and Commissioner Chinn seconded to authorize Chief Andrews to engage ESCi to move forward with the proposal as presented. **MOTION CARRIED.** 

**Agenda Bill 2: 2022 Financial Statements** – Finance Manager outlined the highlights of the 2022 Financial activities. The District ending the year in a strong position financially due to a number of factors including more CCFD3 transports, higher interest rates received and two large donations. Expenses were less than projected with many delays in large ticket item purchases such as apparatus. A Budget Workshop to determine the Commissioners priorities for 2024 will take place March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 1 pm. **NO ACTION REQUESTED. INFORMATION ONLY** 

**Agenda Bill 3:** Approval of Payroll and Expense Claims for Period Ending February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023, Commissioners conducted their review of the expense claims and payroll reports. Commissioner Miano moved and Commissioner Nicholas seconded to approve Accounts Payable Claim check numbers 110956 through 111023 dated February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023 totaling \$152,516.50; Payroll EFT's and IRS deposit Monthly Payroll Draw dated January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023, in the amount of \$48,876.04, Monthly Payroll EFT's and IRS Deposit dated February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, in the amount of \$739,235.84; for a disbursement grand total equaling \$940,628.38 Commissioner Miano moved and Commissioner Nicholas seconded approval of payroll and expense claims for period ending February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023. **MOTION CARRIED**.

**GOOD OF THE ORDER** – FM Whitaker reported that Capt. Cate's L&I claim had been approved. Chief Andrews recounted Legislative Day in Olympia on February 17<sup>th</sup>. He and Commissioners Miano

and Nicholas were able to meet with all three Legislators from our area. AC Orr reported that the Battalion Chief testing process is complete and the tests are currently being validated. Chiefs interviews took place on Saturday February 18th for candidates from out of the area and will continue thru this week for in house candidates. The individuals chosen to fill the three new positions will be announced on February 28<sup>th</sup> and if the newly created bargaining unit is approved by PERC, the BC's will have a start date of May 1<sup>st</sup>.
